
OUR MISSION:

- 64 Donor Advised Funds with \$6,759,929 in assets distributed \$1,787,829 to nonprofits
- 51 Endowed Funds with \$11,172,508 in assets distributed \$186,935 to nonprofits
- 53 Fiscal Sponsorship Funds with \$1,502,229 in assets
- 9 Scholarship Funds with \$225,061 in assets
- \$256,498 awarded in competitive grants to 116 nonprofit programs in 8 areas of interest
- 307 Women to Women Giving Circle members with \$368,260 in endowed funds
- 18 Youth Engaged in Philanthropy members from 4 local schools, \$45,693 in endowed funds
