



2021 PHILANTHROPIST OF THE YEAR NOMINATION FORM

In 2021, Illinois Prairie Community Foundation will award two Philanthropist of the Year awards – one for Bloomington-Normal and the other for outside the Twin Cities (other parts of McLean County, plus all of DeWitt, Livingston and Logan counties). Nominees will be asked to identify the applicant based on where the impact of their philanthropic work is done (not necessarily where they reside).

**Philanthropy is about generosity in all its many forms,
commonly referred to as gifts of “time, talent and treasure.”**

Criteria for nomination – an individual, couple or family residing in McLean, DeWitt, Livingston or Logan County who demonstrates:

- Impact of philanthropic efforts
- Willingness to serve in leadership roles, providing vision and the ability to involve others in philanthropic activity.
- Outstanding civic responsibility through voluntary commitment of time and contributions of financial resources

A relationship with the Community Foundation is desirable but not required.
Current IPCF Board members and staff are not eligible for nomination.

Top two nominees not selected in previous year will automatically be considered for current year.
