





OUR MISSION:


To connect people who care with causes that matter by offering philanthropic leadership, organization and grant-making for the long-term enrichment of our community.

OUR REACH (figures as of June 30, 2021):

- \$23,457,343 in assets, a 18% increase over 2020 figures
- \$1,725,282 gifted to nonprofits in our community, state and country
- 55 Donor Advised Funds with \$7,484,024 in assets distributed \$637,618 to nonprofits
- 52 Endowed Funds with \$14,063,349 in assets distributed \$117,741 to nonprofits
- 55 Fiscal Sponsorship Funds with \$1,357,786 in assets
- 10 Scholarship Funds with \$234,288 in assets
- \$191,585 awarded in competitive grants to 86 nonprofit programs in 8 areas of interest
- 315 Women to Women Giving Circle members with \$446,115 in endowed funds
- 13 Youth Engaged in Philanthropy members from 4 local schools, \$57,559 in endowed funds
